## **Huntington Beach Art Center Presents**

# 11<sup>th</sup> Annual Creative Visions March 24 – April 8, 2017



Huntington Beach, CA – The Huntington Beach
Art Center presents *Creative Visions*, an annual
exhibition of student art created by students from
grades K-12 representing the Huntington Beach
City School District, the Huntington Beach Union
High School District, and the Ocean View School
District. The program began 13 years ago with the
Huntington Beach Union High School District and
has grown to include the Huntington Beach City
School District and the Ocean View School
District. The young artists featured in the
exhibition are presenting works created in a

variety of mediums. The exhibition will be on view from March 24 – April 8, 2017. The opening reception is on March 24th from 5-10 pm.

The opening reception includes musical and vocal performances by students. During the opening on March 24<sup>th</sup> from 5-8 pm, the Huntington Beach City School District will have musical and vocal performances followed by performances from 8-10 pm by the Huntington Beach Union High School District. There will be a special closing reception for the Ocean View School District on April 7<sup>th</sup> from 5-8 pm which will include musical and vocal performances.

The exhibition is organized by the teachers who represent their districts as arts coordinators, and representatives of the Arts Advantage program: Daina Anderson, HBUHSD; Paul Coulter, HBCSD and Lynn Silver, OVSD.

The Huntington Beach Art Center is a community arts and cultural center serving Huntington Beach and the Southern California region. The Center presents the works of artists producing in all mediums, techniques, and genres. Through exhibitions, performances, film/video screenings, lectures and educational programming, HBAC

serves to advance public awareness and understanding of cultural, historic, and contemporary perspectives. HBAC creates opportunities for local, regional and national artists and the community to share in a climate of experimentation, education and experience.

The Huntington Beach Art Center is a public/private partnership between the City of Huntington Beach and the Huntington Beach Art Center Foundation. During its 20 years of operation, the Art Center has achieved a regional and national reputation for featuring the work of emerging artists from all backgrounds and viewpoints.
